Section 3 - Hazards Identification

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

Appearance: clear yellow liquid.

Danger! Causes eye and skin burns. Causes digestive and respiratory tract burns. May cause allergic skin reaction. Contact with moisture liberates methanol.

Potential Health Effects

Eye: Causes eye burns.

Skin: Causes skin burns. May cause skin sensitization, an allergic reaction, which becomes evident upon re-exposure to this material.

Ingestion: Causes gastrointestinal tract burns.

Inhalation: May cause irritation of the respiratory tract with burning pain in the nose and throat, coughing, wheezing, shortness of breath and pulmonary edema. Causes chemical burns to the respiratory tract. Inhalation may be fatal as a result of spasm, inflammation, edema of the larynx and bronchi, chemical pneumonitis and pulmonary edema.

Section 4 - First Aid Measures

Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, occasionally lifting the upper and lower eyelids. Get medical aid immediately.

Skin: Get medical aid immediately. Immediately flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes.
